Open Port

Incheon Open Port Area holds a history of 130 years of operation since its opening in 1883. The entire area is a museum and cultural heritage site. An eco-friendly tram will take you through a customized Open Port course as if you're driving your own car. A special in-depth tour is also available for those who love history.

Jeondeungsa Temple

Jeondeungsa Temple is the oldest temple in Korea, with a history stretching from the Dangun era to the late period of Joseon. With a natural landscape and traditional buildings, the temple is visited by over 600 thousand people every year. Seonbuljang Pavilion and Wolsongyo House are Hanok buildings, where sendentary-style small events can be held.

IAFOR facilitates Livestream Presentations that allow real-time interaction between attendees during the online day of the conference. This creates opportunities for interaction, knowledge transfer, and feedback in the form of questions and critique. Virtual Presentations are pre-recorded and added to the IAFOR Online Video Archive before the conference begins, where they remain indefinitely.
