Programme Structure

Day 1 (Online)

Held during an IAFOR conference and focuses on the hard skills that allow students to operate as an effective communicator during presentations. Participants will deliver a **Poster Presentation** to delegates attending the associated IAFOR conference. Participants will receive a **Certificate of Participation** after attending the symposium.
